### Gradual Reopening

The Family Law division will open to the public Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. (lobby and phone). Face coverings and social distancing required.

## May 29

### Restricted Access

Only individuals and attorneys filing or appearing on the following cases may enter the courthouse:

- Domestic Violence Restraining Orders
- Temporary Ex-Parte (same day and with notice)
- New filings (only when filed with the request for temporary orders)
- Hague Conventions (international kidnapping)

All other filings must be processed using the drop box, mail, fax, or Turbo Court. To request a copy from your court file or for forms go to [www.sb-court.org](http://www.sb-court.org) or visit the Document Control Office inside the Courthouse.
