GENERAL ORDER OF THE
PRESIDING JUDGE

A person willfully failing to pay bail in installments as agreed to under Vehicle Code Section 40510.5 or a lawfully imposed fine for a violation of a provision of the Vehicle Code or a local ordinance adopted pursuant to the Vehicle Code within the time authorized by the court and without lawful excuse having been presented to the court on or before the date the bail or fine is due is guilty of a misdemeanor regardless of the full payment of the bail or fine after that time. If a person fails to make an installment payment according to an agreement made under Vehicle Code Section 40510.5(a), the court may charge a failure to appear or pay under Vehicle Code Section 40508 and it may impose a civil assessment as provided in Penal Code Section 1214.1, or it may issue an arrest warrant for a failure to appear.

This blanket order applies to all traffic cases in which the court assessed a failure to appear or pay fine under Vehicle Code Section 40508(b) and/or a civil assessment under Penal Code Section 1214.1.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that in all traffic cases where the court confirms that a person paid a balance due through Revenue Recovery, any fines or civil assessments imposed by the court under Vehicle Code Section 40508(b) and/or Penal Code Section 1214.1 shall be dismissed and the case closed.

This order is effective January 1, 2024, and supersedes all previous general order entitled *Dismissing Assessments Ordered under VC 40508(b)* and *PC 1241.1* when Paid Through Revenue Recovery (formerly Central Collections), issued by previous Presiding Judges. This order remain in effect until December 31, 2025.
