

### **Traffic and Non Traffic Infractions**

The San Bernardino Superior Court now offers **Reserve a Court Date** in place of the same day walk-in hearings for **Traffic and Non Traffic Infractions** .

- Traffic and Non Traffic Infractions (Reserve a Court Date is available on-line, by Kiosk, in person or by telephone.

The Fontana District schedules **Traffic and Non Traffic Infraction** matters on Monday through Friday at 8:00 am and 1:30 pm.

Most Infraction matters do not require a mandatory court appearance and may be handled prior to the appearance date written on the citation. If you were cited for an infraction which requires a mandatory appearance, **you must Reserve a Court Date** on or before the date indicated on your citation, letter, or any other notice to appear. A warrant for your arrest may be issued if you fail to appear on the date indicated, and/or a Failure to Appear hold may be reported to the Department of Motor Vehicles.

The bail amount may be paid via mail, phone, Kiosk or internet. You may also sign up for traffic school if eligible or request an extension by phone, internet, and kiosks without coming to the clerk's office. Please have your citation number available to expedite the use of these services.

For Reserved Hearings: please check the electronic calendars for your name and report directly to the courtroom. **Do not wait in line if your name is shown on the electronic calendar.** If your name is not on the calendar, please check with a clerk at the criminal/traffic windows.

### **Kiosk**

The Kiosks are currently located at the Fontana, Rancho Cucamonga and Victorville Districts for your convenience. The Kiosks are available to pay citations in full, make a payment, request an extension, reserve a court date or sign up for traffic school. The Kiosk does not accept cash, you must pay with a credit or debit card.

### **Night Court**

*Effective March 1, 2013, Night Court services are no longer provided.*

### **Felony /Misdemeanor**
