LAST-DAY DEADLINE EXTENSIONS EXPIRE FOR CRIMINAL TRIALS AND PRELIMINARY HEARINGS

SAN BERNARDINO, CA—On March 29, 2022, the court issued a <u>General Order</u> extending the last-day deadlines for criminal trials and preliminary examinations. At this time, the court will not be requesting another emergency order and the extension for last-day deadlines expires on April 30, 2022.

The court asks for your continued patience and understanding as we manage the COVID backlogs with the limited courtroom resources. The court continues to gradually restore court services, focusing on processing the filing backlogs resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic.

"We look forward to working with the District Attorney's Office, Law Offices of the Public Defender, and all of our justice partners to continue to provide access to justice and restoring services back to pre-pandemic levels," said Presiding Judge R. Glenn Yabuno.

All court users affected by any potential dismissals should check the court's website (www.sb-court.org) using the Court Access Portal (CAP) to access case information online. All court users, including litigants and private attorneys, will need to register on CAP to access minute orders, purchase documents, and search by name. To complete the registration process, court users must visit https://cap.sb-court.org/ and provide their name, phone number, email, and choose a password.
