SELF-HELP RESOURCE CENTER AVAILABLE IN NEEDLES EFFECTIVE APRIL 1, 2022

SAN BERNARDINO, CA— Effective on Friday, April 1, 2022, San Bernardino Superior Court (SBSC) will resume providing Self-Help services at the Needles Courthouse, located at 1111 Bailey Avenue, in Needles, CA.

Open to the public on the first Friday of each month from 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m., litigants can receive free assistance with family law, child support, guardianship, landlord/tenant, and small claims cases. Self-Help staff can provide information on legal processes and procedures, answer questions, provide resources and tools to assist with preparing necessary forms, and review completed forms to ensure all areas necessary to successfully file the forms have been addressed.

All services are provided on a first-come, first-served basis. Litigants must not be represented by an attorney to receive Self-Help services. Self-Help staff cannot provide legal advice, and therefore no attorney-client relationship is established.
